With the weather getting colder, snow will eventually be here. Please start to make arrangements as to where and how you will be parking your vehicles this winter. City crews removing the snow from the streets is a very time-consuming job and can be done more efficiently if we have residents cooperating with us.

The city does have a 24-Hour parking ordinance which is enforced more in the wintertime to get people to move their cars to allow for street clean up. Vehicles not moved in a timely manner will be ticketed and possibly buried in the snow drift the plow leaves behind.

Please use these suggestions to help cut down the time and costs of plowing our city streets.

- Park off street whenever possible.
- Move your vehicle to a recently plowed area whenever possible. Even across the street will help!!
- Do not park in the exact same spot during every snowfall. This creates a permanent snow berm that is hard to remove once the snow freezes.
- DO NOT DEPOSIT SNOW from your property on to the city roadway.

Many cities have a winter parking ordinance that states “no street parking” all winter long. Main Ave has winter parking restrictions as well as a couple problem streets that have no parking in the winter. Main Street has been beautiful due to the new parking restrictions and most of the town cleans up very nicely when there are no vehicles in the way of the city crew.

Please work with the Frazee Public Works and Police Department for clean and safe streets this winter.
