

Winter Season has Begun

Winter Parking: During snowfall events please refrain from parking on either side of the street. This allows our snow removal crew the ability to more efficiently clear snow from city streets. The cost for snow removal increases when crews have to go back and plow areas where parked vehicles have not been moved. Residents can help reduce costs and snow can be removed more quickly by removing all items (cars, trailers, etc.) including garbage cans from the street whenever you see snow in the forecast.

Winter Driving Survival Kit: While most are cautious about traveling in extreme winter weather; how many of you have a survival kit in your car that should you encounter getting stuck could help you out?

Here a few suggested items to include:

Shovel, flashlight, snacks, first aid kit, essential medications, flares/ reflectors to signal for help, extra batteries, jumper cables, snow/ice scraper & windshield washer fluid.
