PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES:

No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall conduct business in any of the following manners:

- A. Calling attention to his or her business or items to be sold by means of blowing any horn or whistle, ringing any bell, crying out, or by any other noise, so as to be unreasonably audible within an enclosed structure.
- B. Obstructing the free flow of either vehicular or pedestrian traffic on any street, alley, sidewalk or other public right-of-way.
- C. No sales of goods, wares or merchandise may be made from a stationary stand or vehicle on public streets or public street rights of way.
- D. Conducting business in a way as to create a threat to the health, safety and welfare of any individual or the general public.
- E. Conducting business before 8:00 A.M. or after 9:00 P.M.
- F. Failing to provide proof of license and identification when requested or using the license of another person.
- G. Making any false or misleading statements about the product or service being sold, including untrue statements of endorsement. No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall claim to have the endorsement of the city solely based on the city having issued a license to that person.
- H. Remaining on the property of another when requested to leave, or to otherwise conduct business in a manner, a reasonable person would find obscene, threatening, intimidating or abusive.
