Utility Bill Reminder

To ensure your payment is processed quickly and accurately, please include your **full utility account number** on all bank checks or bill pay submissions. When the city implemented a new utility billing software system, account numbers changed slightly. Please double-check and use the updated account number listed on your current bill. This helps us apply your payment to the correct account without delays. Thank you for helping us serve you better!

Example Utility Billing Account Number:
02-00002125-00-8

For convenience, the zeros following the first dash (-) may be omitted:
02-2125-00-8

Understanding Your City Utility Billing Cycle

City utility (water, sewer, garbage & recycling) usage is billed based on a delayed cycle to ensure accurate tracking and processing.



Here's how it works: Utilities used during a given month are measured and processed at the end of the month. The used amount is billed out at the beginning of the next month. Payment is due by the first of the month after the bill is sent, giving you ample time to review and pay.

For example, **July usage** is reflected on the **August bill**, which is **due by September 1**. This cycle helps ensure that you are only billed for what you actually use.

Annual Billing Cycle at a Glance

Utilities Used	Billing Month	Payment Due
January	February	March 1
February	March	April 1
March	April	May 1

Hydrant Flushing Notice—September



Frazee Public Works will be flushing hydrants throughout the month of September as part of our routine maintenance. This important process helps maintain water quality and system performance by clearing out natural mineral deposits that build up in the water mains over time.

During this period, you may temporarily notice discolored water or particles coming from your faucets. If this happens, simply run cold water for a few minutes until it clears.
