Water Conservation Matters

As we move through the warmer months, residents are encouraged to practice water conservation whenever possible. Simple steps can help reduce water usage and lower utility costs:

- Water lawns early in the morning or later in the evening to minimize evaporation.
- Repair leaking faucets, toilets, and irrigation systems promptly.
- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean driveways and sidewalks.
- Run dishwashers and washing machines only with full loads.
- Trim two minutes off your shower time and save up to 10 gallons of water per day.

Even small leaks can waste thousands of gallons of water each year. Monitoring your water usage regularly can help identify problems before they become costly.



Keep Your Contact Information Current

The City may need to contact property owners or utility customers regarding important matters such as:

- Unusually high water usage
- Potential water leaks
- Emergency repair work
- Service interruptions
- Utility billing questions

Please ensure your current phone number, mailing address, and email address are on file with the Utility Billing Department. Updated contact information helps us communicate important information quickly and efficiently when needed.

Noxious Weeds and Tall Grass Reminder

Residents are reminded to maintain their properties in accordance with City ordinances regarding noxious weeds and grass height.

Property owners are responsible for:

- Controlling noxious weeds on their property.
- Mowing grass and vegetation before it becomes excessively tall.
- Keeping yards, vacant lots, and other properties clean and well maintained.

Failure to comply with City ordinances may result in enforcement action. Maintaining properties helps keep our community safe, attractive, and enjoyable for everyone.
